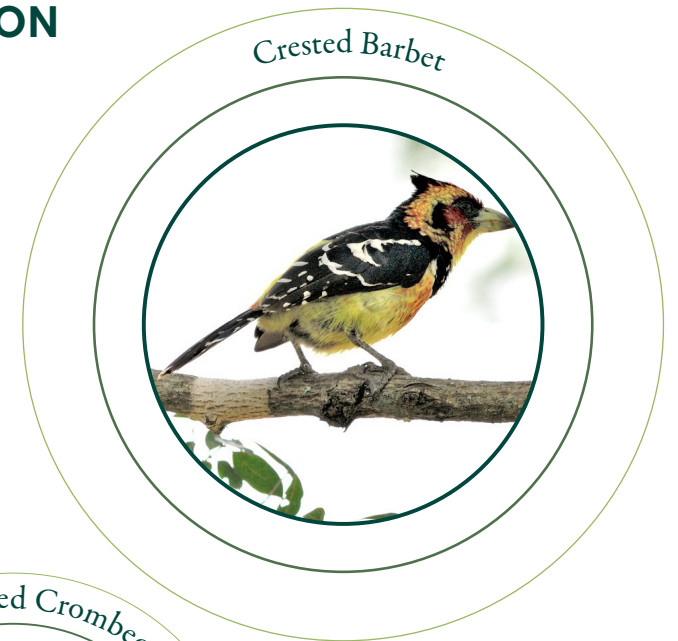
65 YEARS OF GOMBE:

A LEGACY OF DISCOVERY & PROTECTION

Even after 65 years, Gombe continues to reveal its secrets. Recently, JGI's research team, led by Dr. Lilian Pintea and Dr. Deus Mjungu, made an exciting discovery — six bird species never before recorded in Gombe National Park. Using specialized audio recorders placed throughout the forest, the team captured sounds of Gombe's rich biodiversity. With the expert guidance of ornithologists and support of our partners at Rainforest Connect and WildMon, JGI Scientific Advisor and Filmmaker, Bill Wallauer analyzed hours of recordings to identify these birds — species previously known elsewhere in Africa but never documented in Gombe until now. Their presence sheds new light on the park's ecosystem, demonstrating just how much remains to be discovered.

This discovery is not just about birds — it is about what Gombe represents. From Dr. Jane Goodall's first observations of chimpanzees making and using tools to today's scientific breakthroughs, Gombe has shaped how we understand and protect the natural world. It has been a living hub of research for decades, guiding conservation efforts that extend far beyond its borders. What we learn here informs global policies, strengthens community-led conservation, and helps safeguard biodiversity across Africa and beyond.

As we celebrate Gombe's 65th anniversary this year, we recognize its enduring impact. Every discovery reinforces why this park remains vital — not just as a place of research, but as a symbol of hope for conservation. Thanks to ongoing research and the support of donors like you, we continue to uncover its hidden wonders and ensure its protection for generations to come. Gombe's story is far from over, and with your help, its legacy of discovery and protection will continue to shape the future of conservation.

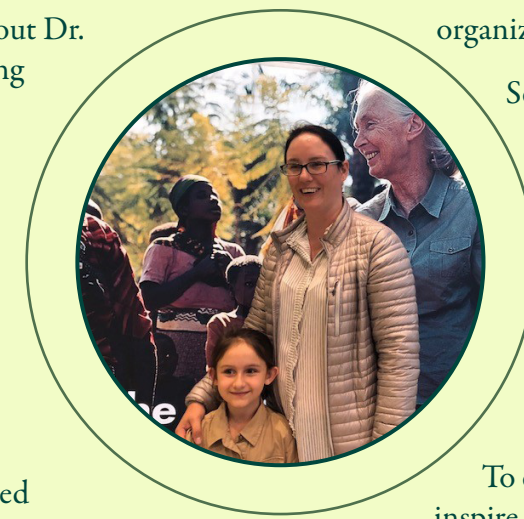
THE JANE EFFECT:
