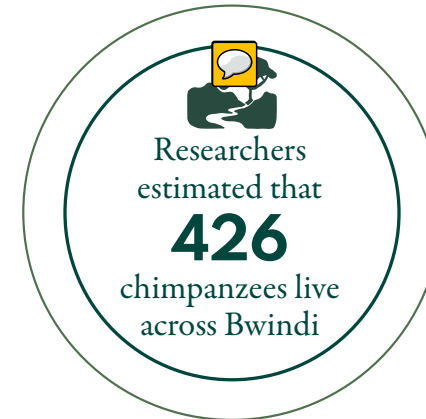

A LANDMARK CENSUS IN BWINDI'S FORESTS

Deep within Uganda's Bwindi Impenetrable National Park, a remarkable discovery has brought new hope for one of our closest relatives.

Last year, the Jane Goodall Institute helped lead the first comprehensive census of Eastern chimpanzees in Bwindi. Conducted in partnership with the Uganda Wildlife Authority and the Greater Virunga Transboundary Collaboration, the survey set out to answer a question that had long remained uncertain: How many chimpanzees live in these forests?



Earlier this year, the results were announced. Researchers estimated that 426 chimpanzees live across Bwindi, moving through its dense forests and steep mountain slopes. This is a meaningful population for an endangered species with as few as 350,000 individuals remaining in the wild.

Bwindi is best known as a sanctuary for mountain gorillas, but the census revealed that chimpanzees are not just rare visitors to this landscape. They are an essential part of the forest community, living throughout the park and sharing this remarkable ecosystem with gorillas, forest elephants, and many other species.

During the survey, teams walked more than 120 square miles of forest, documenting signs of wildlife and gaining a deeper understanding of how species live alongside one another in this protected landscape. The work helps guide conservation efforts that protect entire ecosystems, ensuring that chimpanzees, gorillas, and countless other animals continue to thrive together.

This knowledge will shape conservation decisions for years to come. It also helps strengthen Uganda's Chimpanzee Conservation Strategy ensuring that chimpanzees receive the protection they deserve alongside other great apes.

With continued commitment and care, the forests of Bwindi will remain a place where wildlife flourishes and where future generations will still hear the calls of chimpanzees echoing through the trees.

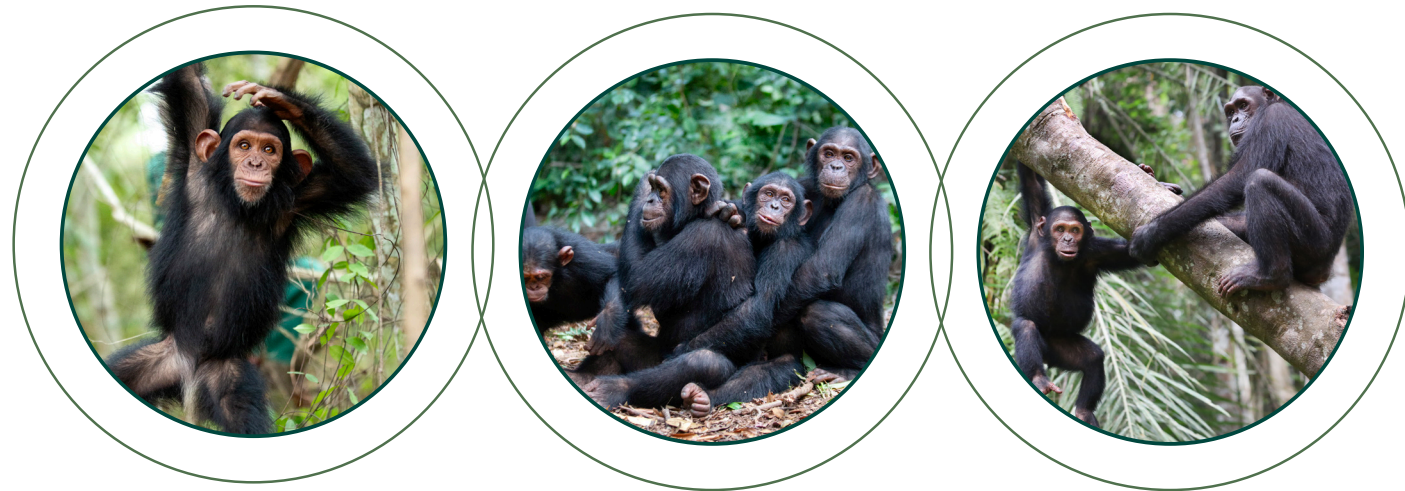

You may also make a one-time, tax-free gift of up to \$55,000 to fund a CGA from your qualified charitable distribution (QCD).

CGAs are flexible and can be set up so that payments are made to either one or two beneficiaries. This is a creative way to meet the long-term financial needs of a spouse, family member, or friend.

3. Guaranteed, Fixed Payments Rates

CURRENT CGA PAYMENT RATES AT A GLANCE

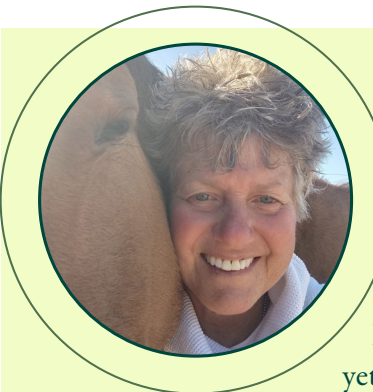

I have always felt the pull of the natural world. Even as a child, I knew it was where I belonged. I just didn't have the words for it yet. As I got older, that feeling only deepened. Today, it shapes everything I do.

When I travel, it's for moments that take your breath away. Watching whales rise from the ocean in Maui, standing in the presence of gorillas in Uganda, or dreaming of the day I can witness jaguars moving through Patagonia. My life is enriched when I can witness wildlife in their own environment.

Nature has always been more than something beautiful to me. It's where I feel closest to something greater than myself. It's where I find peace and connection. My admiration for Dr. Jane Goodall has long been part of my journey. She represents something rare. When she first traveled to Tanzania, she witnessed a world that was still, in many ways, untouched. She brought that back to us not just through science, but through story.

Jane helped us see what exists, and what is at risk of disappearing. She helped us understand that conservation is not only about protecting animals. It's about people, too. That perspective changed the way I see the world and why I feel so connected to the Jane Goodall Institute. The work reflects the full picture of conservation. It supports wildlife, but it also supports people and communities.

I don't have children. My animals are my family. That has made me think deeply about what I want to leave behind. I've spent my life building something, and I want it to continue to have meaning. I want my legacy to help protect the world that has given me so much. That is what led me to include JGI USA in my will.

We are living in a time when the natural world is under immense pressure. You can see it and you can feel it. Places that once felt untouched are changing. There is a growing sense of urgency and at times, it can feel overwhelming. But I still hold onto hope. That's what Jane gave the world and that's what JGI continues to carry forward.
