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Jane Goodall Hike for Hope Code of Conduct

Purpose

This event is intended to celebrate Dr. Jane Goodall's message of hope, environmental stewardship, respect for all living things, and community action. Participants are expected to contribute to a safe, welcoming, inclusive, and respectful experience for everyone.

Independent Event Disclaimer

This event is independently organized by the host and is not sponsored, endorsed, controlled, supervised, or operated by the Jane Goodall Institute (JGI).

Respect for Others & Nature

Participants agree to:

- Treat all participants with kindness, dignity, and respect.
- Welcome people of all backgrounds, identities, ages, abilities, and experience levels.
- Avoid harassment, intimidation, discrimination, or disruptive behavior.
- Respect differing viewpoints and experiences.
- Follow Leave No Trace principles.
- Stay on designated trails where applicable.
- Avoid disturbing wildlife, vegetation, or natural habitats.
- Properly dispose of litter and personal waste

Health and Safety

Participants are responsible for:

- Assessing their own ability to participate.
- Bringing appropriate water, clothing, footwear, medications, and supplies.
- Following local laws, trail rules, and park regulations.
- Making safe decisions based on weather, terrain, and physical conditions.
- Reporting hazards, injuries, or unsafe conduct to the event organizer.

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Photography and Media

Participants should:

- Respect the privacy of others.
- Obtain permission before posting identifiable photographs of individuals, especially minors.
- Avoid representing themselves as official JGI representatives.
- Avoid creating materials that suggest JGI sponsorship or endorsement.

Use of Jane Goodall's Name and JGI Marks

Participants may not:

- Use JGI logos, trademarks, or branding without written permission.
- Solicit donations on behalf of JGI unless expressly authorized.
- Use Jane Goodall's name, image, or likeness in a way that implies endorsement.

Commercial Activities

Unless specifically approved by the organizer:

- No unauthorized fundraising.
- No sales or commercial promotion.
- No political campaigning.
- No activities inconsistent with the spirit of the event.

Organizer Authority

The organizer reserves the right to:

- Address violations of this Code of Conduct.
- Ask participants to modify inappropriate behavior.
- Remove participants whose conduct threatens the safety, well-being, or enjoyment of others.
